# DETROIT NATIVE AMY NEDERLANDER LAUNCHES EXCELLENCE CORPS PROGRAM AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS ACROSS THE CITY

Encouraging Detroit's Future Leaders to Find Their Passion and Make it Happen

**DETROIT, MICH.** (July 25, 2018) – L!FE Leadership! Fueled *by* Entrepreneur-ISM recently launched the Excellence Corps community engagement program in partnership with UAW-Ford, Strategic Staffing Solutions, Detroit Public Schools Community District hosted by Cass Technical High School and participating in Grow Detroit's Young Talent. High school students from across Detroit receive training and work experience to foster a deep understanding of Detroit's revival and the city's plans for revitalizing Detroit's neighborhoods through experience-based learning. The program was thoughtfully developed by Detroit native and Strategic Business Consultant with deep roots in the city, Amy Nederlander.

Excellence Corps Summer 2018 program works with high school students five days a week over the course of 5 ½ weeks and builds leadership, goal achievement skills and networking relationships for academic, career and civic responsibility. The program trains participants in public speaking, networking, design thinking and creating strategic plans of action that are impactful for their community. After the intensive training, students have the opportunity to put what they've learned into action by working at Tindal Activity Center four days a week, accompanied by one day a week in the classroom for debriefing, team building, planning and processing of what they experienced.

As part of the students' training and to further immerse them in the community, Excellence Corps works with thought leaders and entrepreneurs in Michigan to speak to the students about their current roles, what motivated them when they were growing up and any other encouraging words and best practices.

The students' work, and their enthusiasm for being actively involved in Detroit's revitalization, is phenomenal. I'm proud of the work that we've done and I look forward to continuing to grow Excellence Corps to include middle and high school students across Detroit.

In addition, the students cultivate and explore visions for the future of Detroit and seek opportunities to be actively involved in making these visions a reality through improvisation, ideation and storytelling. Their work this summer at Tindal Activity Center includes creating renderings for Tindal's expansion plans, developing social media content, enhancing programming, developing a strategic business plan and marketing for ongoing community outreach.

To close out the summer, Excellence Corps students host a Town Hall Presentation as they step up to become founding member of the Excellence Corps Student Leadership Council on Monday, July 30 from 9:45 to 11 a.m. at Cass Technical High School, with guest speakers Senator Debbie Stabenow and Angelique Peterson-Mayberry. The students are presenting on a variety of topics, including why they signed up for the Excellence Corps, what they learned over the summer, what projects they were involved in and immediate next steps.
